

Field Outing, 1967

Tuesday, 4/7/67:

Members of the party arrive in Alice Springs by scheduled transport services. Accommodation on bed and breakfast basis reserved at Mt. Gillen Hotel, Alice Springs.

Wednesday, 5/7/67:

Depart Mt. Gillen Hotel at 8.15 a.m. and travel via the Eleven Mile Hills to Aileron, thence to LUNCH Barrow Creek. Travel via the Devil's Marbles, Wauchope to OVERNIGHT Tennant Creek.

Thursday, 6/7/67:

Depart 8.15 a.m. and travel via Banka Banka and Renner Springs to LUNCH Elliott. Thence via Dunmara and Daly Waters to OVERNIGHT Mataranka Homestead, Mataranka.

Friday, 7/7/67:

Depart 8.15 a.m. and travel via Katherine to LUNCH Pine Creek. Thence via Adelaide River to arrive Darwin approximately 5 p.m. Accommodation on an all inclusive basis at Brooks Private Hotel, 10 Gregory Street, Parap, Darwin, N.T.

Saturday, 8/7/67 to Thursday, 13/7/67:

Daily excursions from Darwin, with picnic lunches provided.

Friday, 14/7/67:

Depart Darwin 8.15 a.m. and travel via Adelaide River to Pine Creek for lunch, thence via Goodparla and Barramundie to Nourlangie.

Saturday, 15/7/67; Sunday, 16/7/67:

At Nourlangie with suitable inspections and excursions. OVERNIGHT Nourlangie.

Monday, 17/7/67:

Depart Nourlangie 9.00 a.m. and travel to Katherine with picnic lunch en route, thence to OVERNIGHT Mataranka Homestead.

Tuesday, 18/7/67; Wednesday, 19/7/67; Thursday, 20/7/67:

At Mataranka Homestead, with excursions or inspections as available.

Friday, 21/7/67:

Depart Mataranka 8.15 a.m. and travel via Larrimah and Newcastle Waters to LUNCH Elliott. Thence via Renner Springs to OVERNIGHT Tennant Creek.

Saturday, 22/7/67:

Depart 8.15 a.m. and travel via Wauchope to LUNCH Barrow Creek. Thence via Tea Tree Well and Aileron, to arrive Alice Springs approximately 5 p.m. Accommodation on Dinner, Bed and Breakfast basis at Mt. Gillen Hotel.

Sunday, 23/7/67:

Travel to Southern and Eastern States by scheduled transport services.

CONNECTING TRANSPORT. There are scheduled services by either domestic airline which arrive in Alice Springs on Tuesday, 4th July and depart Sunday, 23rd July, 1967. Group concessions are available for parties of 15 or more persons.

The Commonwealth Railways train, "The Ghan", departs from Adelaide on each Monday and Thursday and from Alice Springs on each Sunday and Wednesday. Extension of accommodation can be arranged at Mt. Gillen, if required.

Pioneer Tours 7 Day Territorian Tour via Woomera Rocket Range, Coober Pedy Opal Fields and Ayers Rock, departs Adelaide each Monday and departs Alice Springs each Wednesday.
