The National Photographic Index of Australian Birds, based at the Australian Museum, Sydney, plans to hold its first exhibition of photographs at the National Library, Canberra, from 19 January to 14 February 1970. From 379 photographs of parrots submitted to the panel, 123 were passed for incorporation in the Index, and a selection of these will be on view at the exhibition.

After the exhibition closes in Canberra it will be on view at the Australian Museum, Sydney, during March and April. It will then be shown at the National Gallery, Melbourne, in May, and after that will be on tour thoughout Australia, under arrangements yet to be worked out.

The requirements are entirely simple.
