## ELEVENTH ANNUAL REPORT OF THE RAOU NEST RECORD SCHEME

Three thousand and eleven cards were returned for the 1974-75 season. This is the second consecutive year in which more than 3,000 cards have been submitted.

Previous annual totals have again been altered by the inclusion of 501 cards for past seasons in the return of 3,011. In their return of 378, M. Brooker, J. Estbergs and and M. S. Jones included 346 cards for past years; eighty of these were for Little Crow and sixty-three for Nankeen Kestrel. The Bird Observers' Club included sixty-four cards from their Simpson Desert trip in their contribution of 342. Mr F. F. James has resigned as representative for the BOC and I wish to express my appreciation and thanks for the considerable help and support he gave me.

Prof. G. L. Maclean included eighteen cards for the Australian Pratincole in his contribution of 175. S. B. Unthank for the second successive year returned forty-six cards for the Red-browed Firetail in his total. A. Pecze sent in twenty-five cards for the Brown Thornbill, all recorded from one property. Each card is of value to the scheme and I thank all contributors for their work and interest in furthering the knowledge of the breeding habits of native and introduced birds. Seventy-one individuals and four corporate bodies contributed to the Scheme and these are listed in Table I.

## RESULTS

The total number of cards in the collection is now 24,128 and the annual totals are as follows:

Four hundred and eighty-three species are represented. There are sixty-five species with 100 or more cards, nine being added this year. These are listed

in Table II. The Welcome Swallow is the first species to reach 1,000 cards. Cards were received for seven species that were not previously represented: Letterwinged Kite and Little Corella (BOC); Nullarbor Quail-thrush (M. S. Jones); Cattle Egret (P. A. Disher and E. Thomas); Black Falcon (P. Congreve); Freckled Duck (R. Garstone); Bar-breasted Honeyeater (D. Grace and P. A. Disher).
