Check list

- Check recent papers for conformity to journal style.
 - **Electronic submission of a Word document as an email attachment is the preferred method of submission.**
 - Type with double-spacing on A4-sized paper and all pages should be numbered consecutively.
 - Title page—the first page of the manuscript should contain the title of the paper, the names and full address(es) of the author(s), with superscripts (A, B, C, etc.) relating the authors to their addresses. Include a suggested short title (less than 50 letter spaces).
 - If sending hard copy, send 3 copies and an electronic version on a floppy disc.
 - Authorities for Latin binomials are only required in taxonomic papers.
 - Units—use kg/ha not kg ha⁻¹. Abbreviation for litre is ‘L’; millilitre is ‘mL’.
 - Each Table and graph should be on a separate page. Use the Table formatting style in a word processor. Do not use tabs or the space bar to form columns. Use superscripts (A, B, C, etc.) for Table footnotes. Do not use vertical rules in Tables.
 - Figures—in the text and in the captions, use the abbreviated style of Fig. 1 (not Figure 1). Captions to Figures should be typed on a separate page placed after the Tables. All lines should be typed flush left.
 - Footnotes are used in Tables only, NOT in the text.
 - References—spell out the names of all periodicals, publishers, conference proceedings and books in full. If using ‘Reference Manager’ or ‘ProCite’ software, visit <http://www.isiresearchsoft.com> to obtain our style file, listed as ‘Australian Journal of Experimental Agriculture’.
 - Include an Assignment of Copyright form available from the above website.
