Erythrism in Birds' Eggs.—I refer to Mr. E. F. Boehm's notes in *The Emu*, vol. 50, p. 139. In a nesting colony of Silver Gulls (*Larus novæ-hollandiæ*), on an island off Port Kembla, N.S.W., several reddish-coloured eggs were found, often being associated with a pure white egg.
