^A Two books were included in this review – the first published in 2005, and the second, its sequel, published in 2014. Both were included to highlight the changing nature of this field over the past decade; the updated title, ‘Sexual health: a multidisciplinary approach’, reflects the ongoing recognition of the multidisciplinary nature of sexual health, and the additional content (e.g. sexual health in adolescence and ‘vulnerable populations’ including refugees) highlights the growing priority of these two groups in Australia.
