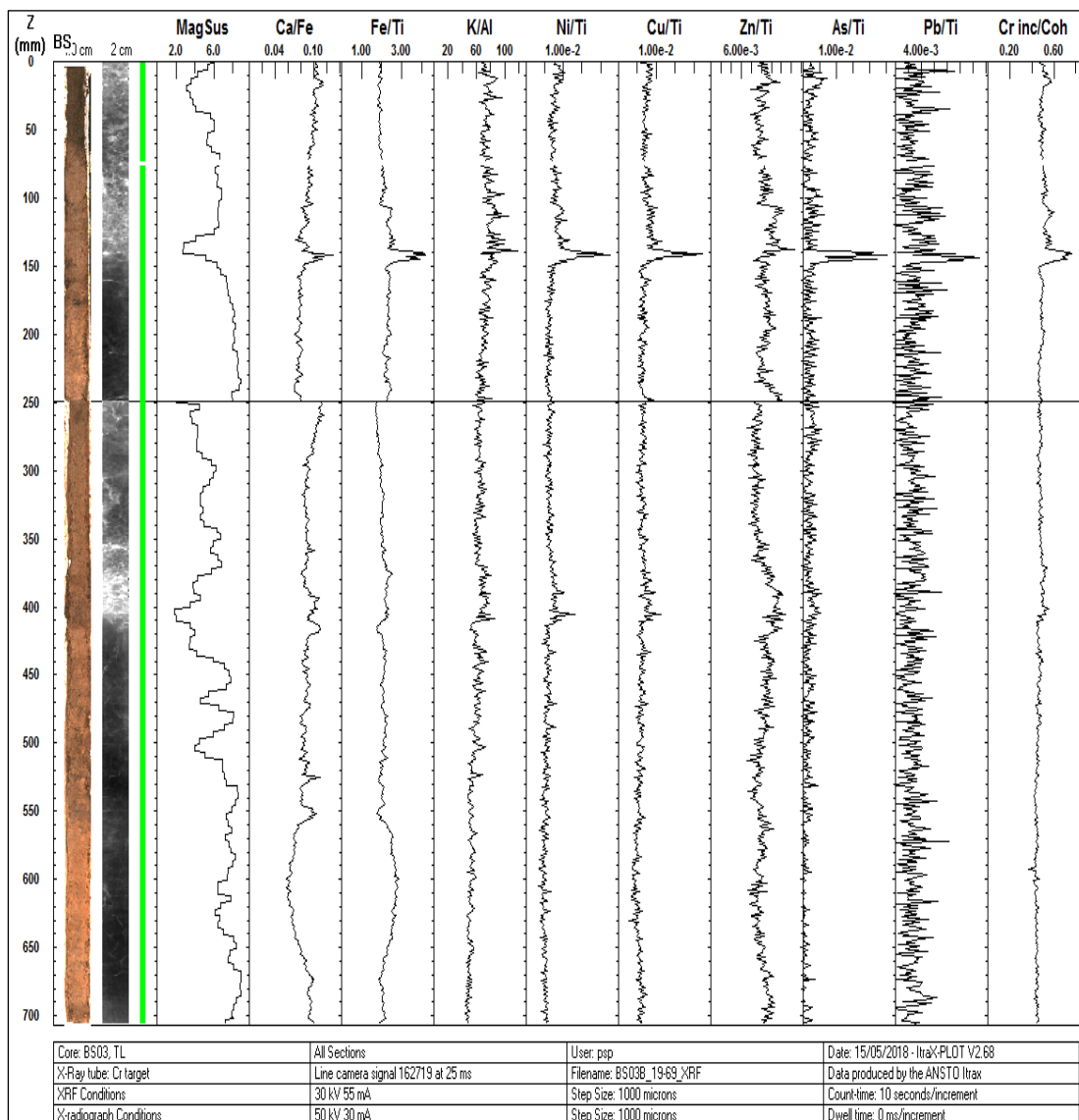


Fig. S1. Graphs of Black Swamp (BS) and Green Swamp (GS), showing elemental Itrax ratio for analysed elements.

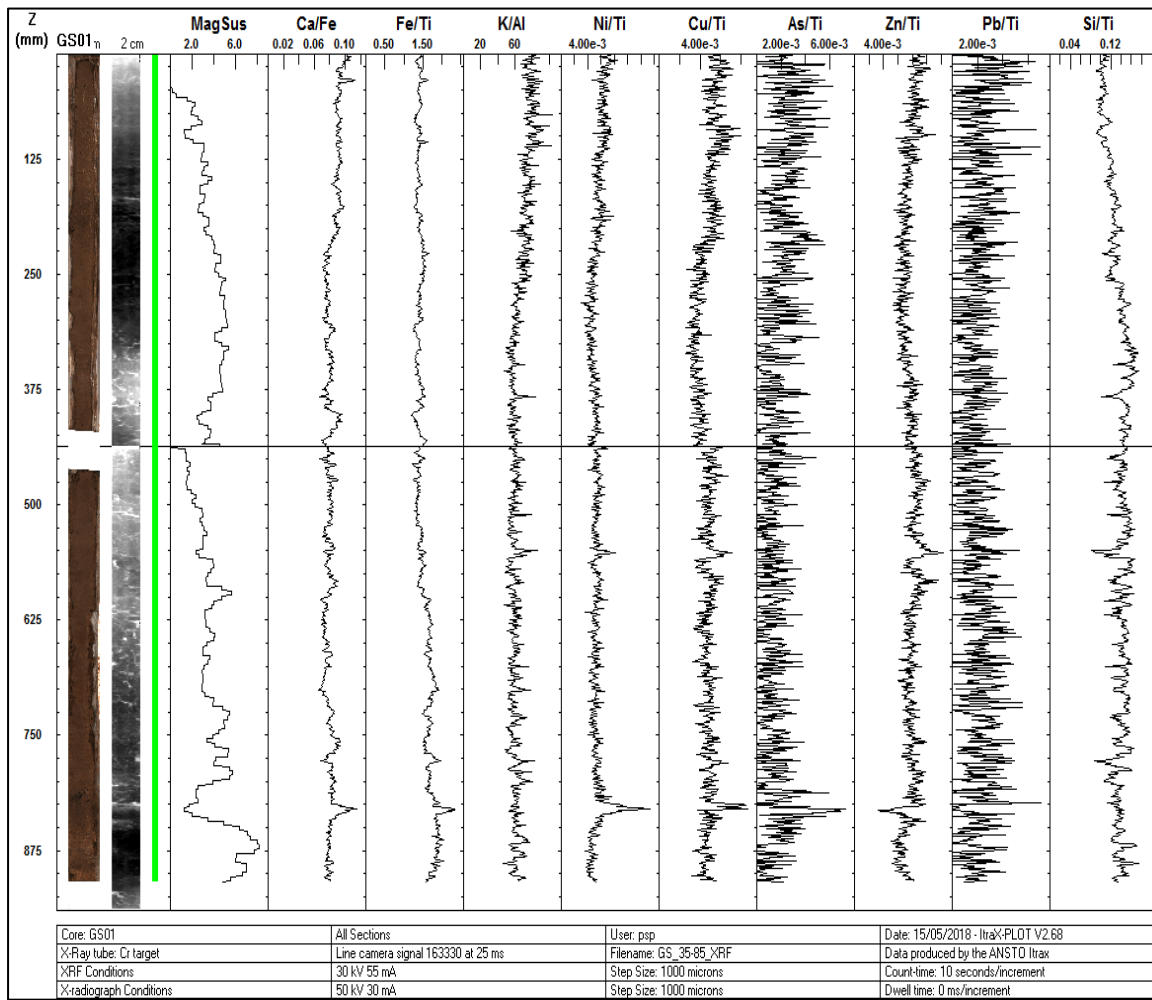
