About the Nudge-a-thon

You are invited to design behavioural interventions (or nudges).

This half-day event will bring teams (of 4-6 people per team) together to <u>develop a digital ad</u> for improving awareness and access to PrEP for overseas born gay, bisexual and other men who have sex with men (MSM). These digital ads will be disseminated through social media and gay dating apps.

Key facts and resources

 Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for HIV is an effective HIV prevention strategy for those at substantial risk of HIV

- Although rates of HIV are decreasing among Australian born MSM, the rates among overseas born MSM remain the same or are rising (Figure S1)
- One of the major differences is the awareness and use of PrEP among overseas born MSM (compared with Australian born MSM)
- There is an urgent need to improve the awareness and use of PrEP among overseas born MSM



Interview Guide

Introduction
