Search Strategy:

Online search for website in English only between 10 May 2020 – 1 June 2020. Google was used as the main search engine. Key words used COVID-19 designated hospitals, hospitals for infectious disease, designated hospitals, COVID-19 hospitals, COVID-19 facilities. Key words were also used in the search function in ABC Australia, ABC USA and BBC UK websites.
