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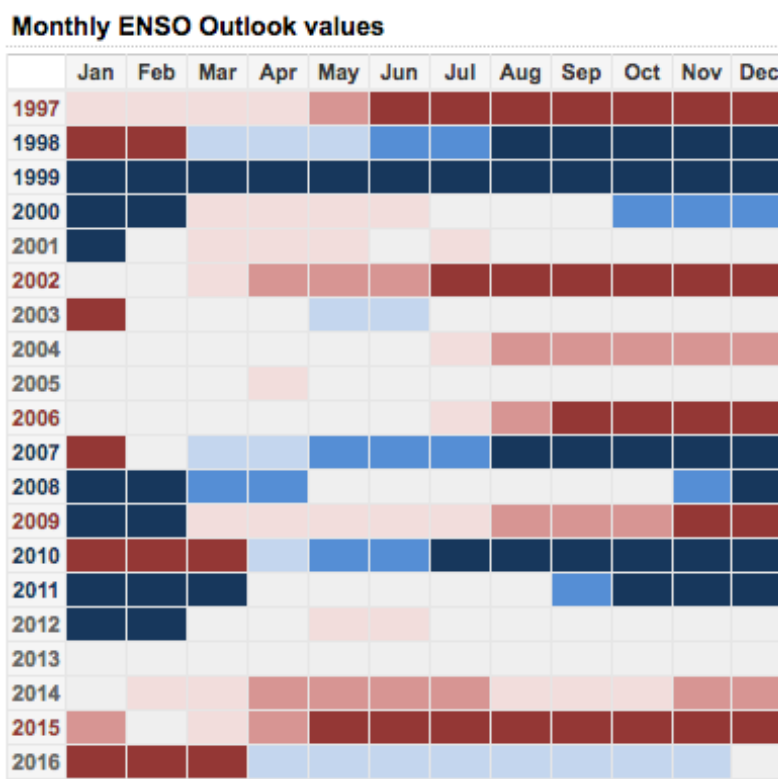


Fig. S1. Monthly likelihood of El Niño (red) and La Niña (blue) events on the basis of El Niño–Southern Oscillation (ENSO). The degree of likelihood increases from light to medium to dark colours, with dark colours representing a confirmed El Niño or La Niña event. Red- or blue-coloured years indicate that the year was dominantly an El Niño or La Niña year respectively.
